



A **WSD Senior trip** affords students that are graduating the opportunity to plan a culminating activity of their educational experience at WSD. Students are responsible for all costs associated with the activities (CDHL will incur no financial costs related to this activity). Students may support this through fundraising. There is no course of study required, nor learning outcomes measured. This is an optional activity.

Senior class sponsors may support the students with pre-planning and budgeting activities, but the primary responsibility for planning the trip lies with the students. Senior trips must be authorized by the principal and then submitted to the superintendent for final approval at least four weeks in advance of the proposed trip. Senior class sponsors are responsible to alert administration for substitute teacher coverage if applicable.

The school nurse must be notified to determine any student medication needs at least two weeks in advance of the trip.
